## Rewards – Christmas 2023

## Rewards – Christmas 2023



This year there will be some changes to how this looks and feels for you and your children, as we seek to increase our rewards and the celebration for students making positive choices. During our end of term celebration assemblies, we will be celebrating the following;

- Students with regular attendance and those who have improved their attendance
- 100% Positive (zero behaviour points)
- Great effort in subjects
- Outstanding progress in subjects
- Most improved in subjects
- Tutee of the term (awarded by tutors to two of their tutor group each term)
- Excellent average attendance across the term (Tutor Group prize) in each Year Group
- Most positive points per tutor group in each year group
- Tutor group quiz winners in each year group

## Rewards - Christmas 2023



As in previous years we will also run focus fortnight rewards at four points through the year. In January there will be a focus fortnight on attendance, this will be repeated in May. This is to allow anyone the chance of being recognised for their effort in attending over short periods, well as the termly and yearly recognition. We all understand the academic and social benefits of good school attendance and so we celebrate overall attendance, improved attendance and periods of good attendance in order to enable a wide range of students to be recognised.

There will also be two 'focus fortnights' based around good behaviour. We recognise that every child has the right to attend disruption free lessons, and anyone who is positively contributing to this also deserves to be recognised. These rewards also go alongside our overall and improvement in behaviour awards.

We look forward to a celebratory end to the term and to enabling our students to end 2023 with further enriching experiences at Court Fields School.
