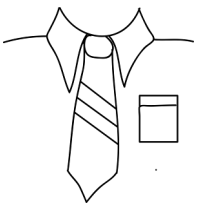

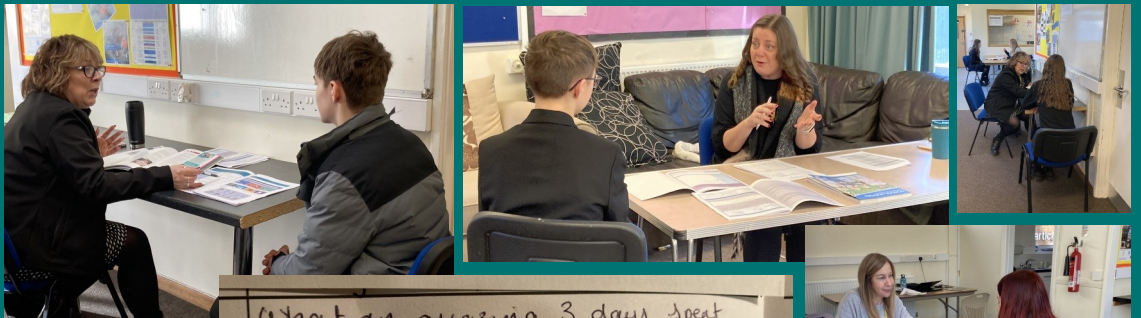


### Borrowing uniform
