Agenda

1. Welcome and minutes from the last meeting.

Polly Matthews welcomed us back to another Parent and Community Meeting. We went around the room and introductions were made (Section 2). We covered the items from the last meeting and reconfirmed the pledges are still in place as seen above. At this point the agenda for this week's meeting was shared and introductions to Mr Jackson Reed for the Performing Arts and Mr Bob House for an update on the Forest School were made.

2. Introduce each person and their guest, as well as 3 ideas/people to support moving forward.

We went around the room and re-introduced ourselves and guests that we had brought in line with our "challenge" from the last meeting to bring three Ideas/people to this meeting. Bob House introduced a friend, Mr Parker from the Living Light Church, who is a big part of the school community, and Andrew Paxton.

Mr Peter Joint introduced two others to the group, Dave Farrow, Benno Hill Director of Wellington Community.

3. Groups visit to practical areas.

We spilt up into two groups visiting two areas,

The Performing Arts Department and Dining Hall, we have a bid in to have a new dining hall and kitchen, if this goes through the current dining hall has great potential to be the new stage for the Performing Arts department.

<u>The Forest School</u>, we have had a new hut built with support from the community with a large, fenced area for these activities, with this area and the Hub Garden needing continued support to make the most of each area.

4. Return to Staff Room in 2 groups and commit to action plan for the rest of this year.

4.1- Forest School

During the tour of the Forest School area, we passed the SEN Garden. It has been agreed to spend a bit of time on this area. The Living Light Church helped to update this area, but it needs some freshening up. It was mentioned to have an all-weather bench and some sort of roof/cover for the area to make a usable space all year round.

We had a review of the of recent upgrade to the Forest School area. This area (with a now in place Forest School Lead) has been in development to reduce cost; currently £200 a day per child for external Forest School provision.

Ideas Brought forward,

- Fundraising click through to websites when people are purchasing goods at home donations/percentage come back to the school.
- Bring in C Slocombe who has pledged time, seeds and experience into the Forest School.
- Contact Mr Whiteman CEO Royal Marines i.e. outdoor events.
- Parent plant donations
- Survey plan in place with Mr B House following on to a focus group with children.

- Tree Protection
- Gardening Club
- Gaining resources from the community i.e. Sleepers (costly items)
- Set up costs and maintenance costs to be considered.

4.2- Performing Arts

A tour of the department and hall lead by Mr J Reed took place to get an idea of the space available and what is needed to bring it back to life and make it a more usable space.
