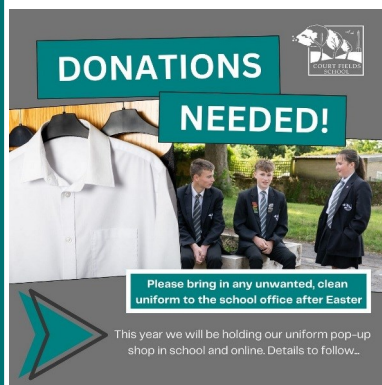

If you have any unwanted school uniform that you would like to donate, we are looking for items for our pop-up shop! Please drop them to the school office. Thank you in advance!

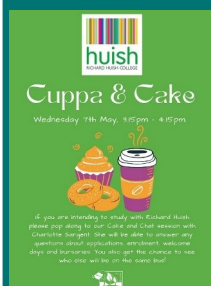


College Cuppa & Cake Session
