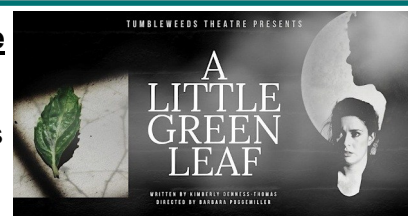
A huge well done to Salvador, Alex, Theo and Lukas on being selected to represent Somerset ACF in the upcoming national rugby finals!

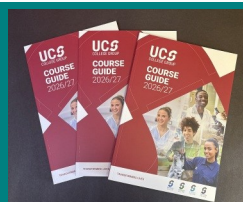
### Somerset Youth Parliament Election
