<p>Research Projects</p>	<p><b>Mini project</b>, take the top 3 cuisines you have found and do a fact sheet for each one. Include, name or country, description photo, key dishes they would eat and key foods. The 3 cuisines can be linked (for example Asian Cuisine looking at Thai, Vietnamese and Japanese) or 3 totally separate ones, the choice is yours.</p> <p><b>My world recipe collection</b> Using the internet find your favourite recipes and create your own mini recipe booklet. Then with permission and supervision you could make them! If you do take photos of them and review each one, add these to your booklet.</p>	<p><b>Poster/Leaflet</b> – Highlighting produce local to the South West. Draw images of regional foods and add a brief description for each, name of produce, where it is grown/caught/reared</p> <p><b>Recipe booklet</b> – Using the ideas of South West produce, use these ingredients and sources relevant recipes. Create a booklet of local recipes. Colourful front page for recipe booklet is essential.</p>	<p><b>Mind map</b> of your favourite choices from the different careers in hospitality and catering. Draw and label or use images from the internet to cut out and paste to create your mind map</p> <p><b>Mini careers studies</b>, take the top 10 careers you have found and do a fact sheet for each one.
