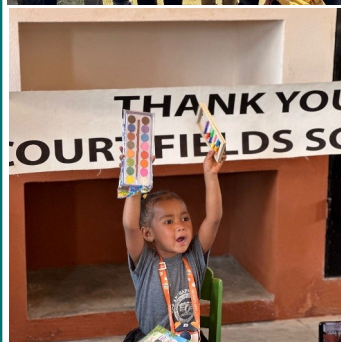

New Classroom Opened in Madagascar

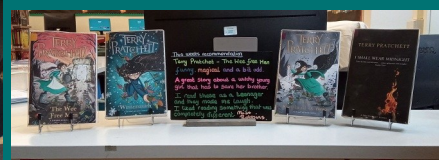

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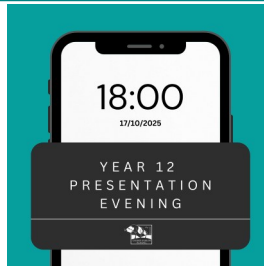
Monument House
