The French PPE in March will take the form of a full Sample PAPER. There will be exams in **Reading & Writing** (done in the Hall) and **Listening** (done during lesson time). There will also be a full mock **Speaking** Assessment, which will take place following the main exams in the final week of term.

The papers will cover the entire syllabus, and you can expect questions on some or all of the following topics. (The relevant page(s) in your Revision Guide (**RG**) / Vocab Book (**VB**) are in brackets).
