Week (Starting)	R032 Topic Focus	Homework Task – Revision	Homework Task – Assessment
Week 1 – 19 January	Topic Area 1: Benefits to service users' health and wellbeing when rights are maintained	Create a revision grid linking each right (choice, confidentiality, consultation, equal and fair treatment, protection from abuse) to benefits such as empowerment, trust and high self-esteem.	Answer two short exam-style questions explaining how maintaining rights improves health and wellbeing.
Week 2 – 26 January	Topic Area 2.1: Person-centred values and the 6Cs	Produce a table defining each person-centred value and the 6Cs, with at least one care-based example for each.	Complete one extended exam-style question applying person-centred values in a health or social care setting.
Week 3 – 2 February	Topic Area 2.2: Benefits of applying person-centred values	Create a comparison chart showing benefits for service users and benefits for service providers.	Answer two exam-style questions linking person-centred values to positive outcomes in care settings.
Week 4 – 9 February	Topic Area 2.2: Effects on health and wellbeing if person-centred values are not applied (PIES)	Revise physical, intellectual, emotional and social effects using a care-based scenario.	Write one extended response analysing the impact across at least two PIES areas.
Week 5 – 16 February	Topic Area 3.1–3.3: Verbal, non-verbal communication and active listening	Create revision notes or flashcards outlining key communication skills, when they are used and their benefits.	Answer scenario-based exam questions explaining how communication skills meet service user needs.
Week 6 – 23 February	Topic Area 3.4–3.5: Special methods of communication and the importance of effective communication	Produce a summary table of special communication methods, including how and when they are used.	Complete a timed PPE-style assessment covering Topic Areas 1–3.
