Fencing Qualifiers

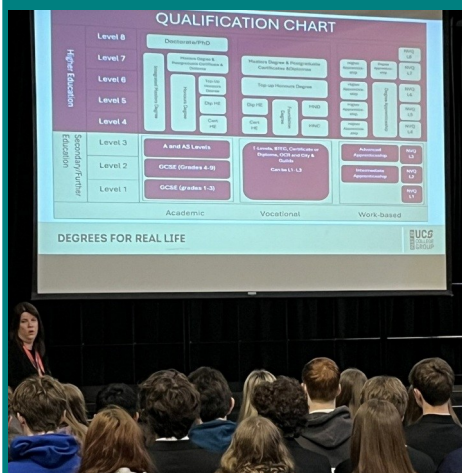
