County Cup Football finalists!

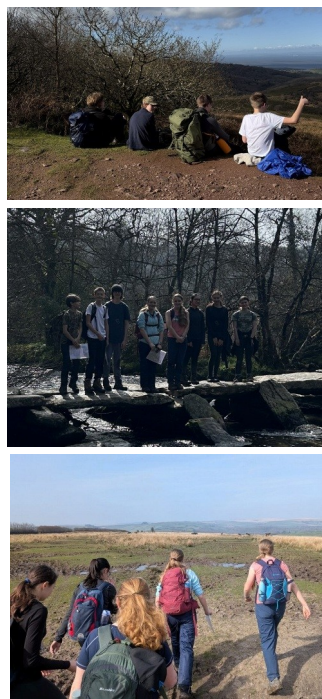
