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Where and when!

- Exams will take place in the
- Sports Hall
- Balcony
- C1 or C2 computer rooms
- Individual timetable
- Individual Seat Number
- Sent via school email



Where and when!

- Registration in the morning will be in tutor
- In the afternoon registration will be recorded in your exam or lesson
- Line up outside the Sports Hall or Exam room at 8:50
- Exams period 1 & 2
- Normal lessons Period 3 (Bring revision materials to school)
- Lunch between P3 and P4 (change of the school day)
- Line up outside the Sports Hall 13:00
- Exams period 4 & 5 or normal lessons
- **When the exam is finished – return to normal lessons**

Exam Conditions



- Individual Timetable with seat numbers (sent via email)
- Line up outside exam room
- Sports Hall (Letters of each column to identify where)
- A-G (Canteen side) H-N (Nugget side)
- Enter Exam Room when asked in silence
- Leave Sports Hall in silence – go outside to wait for others NOT the foyer



Exam Conditions

- Exam Conditions – No talking or non verbal communication
- Mobile Phones turned off and in your bags
- No watches of any sort are allowed to be worn
- Hair tied back so that ears are visible, before you go into the exam room
- Water bottles – no labels, must be clear



Supervision

- All exams are supervised by Invigilators not teachers
- All exams follow the JCQ regulations not school rules
- Lead Invigilator will report any students not following these rules and a report will be made to JCQ. This could affect your final GCSE grades.
- Put your hand up and wait if you have a question or need help
- Let an invigilator know if you have the wrong exam paper
- Know your tier of entry in Maths, Science and Spanish (Foundation or Higher)

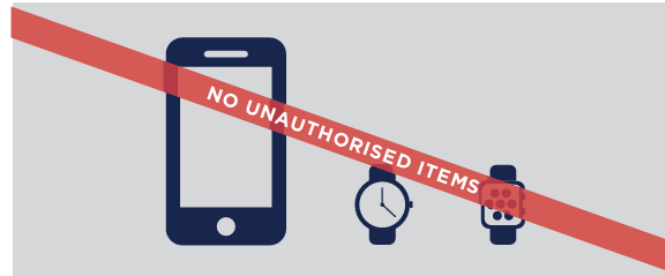
