Once you have submitted your online application form, we will contact you directly with specific details about the audition.

The audition process will follow these steps:

STEP 1 Complete an application form.
STEP 2 Attend the audition and take part in a contemporary and creative class (90 minutes). Show a minute solo, in the style of your choice, and have a short discussion with the panel.
STEP 3 You will be contacted with your results, either offer of a place, a place on the reserve list, or if you have been unsuccessful on this occasion. Expect to hear by 28th March. Successful auditionees will be invited to a taping touch day, later in the year.
