<u>Year 10 End of Year Exams</u>

The end of year examinations for Year 10 will take place between Monday 13th and Wednesday 22nd June. Students will be sitting their examinations during lesson time, in their normal classrooms and will be supervised by their teachers. This will allow us to effectively evaluate the students' progress and identify the gaps in their knowledge, without the additional pressure for students of a formal 'exam-style' environment. In order to balance this against the need to prepare them for the formal exam environment they will sit one Maths and English exam in the Sports Hall on Wednesday 22nd June.

Students will be taking examinations in most of their subjects and teachers will inform students of the exact days and times. These examinations will provide students with an opportunity to test their knowledge and understanding and to identify some topics that will need further improvement as we move into Year 11 and their final GCSE examinations. Parents will be informed of their child's performance via the End of Year Report, which will incorporate the end of year exams and classwork into a Consistent Working Grade.

Lesson time over the next few weeks will be used to support students' revision, however, it is important your child is revising at home. Homework will become a focus for revision and we recommend your child is doing at least an hour each evening if not more. If your child is to be as successful as they can be in these examinations it is vital they are studying at home over the coming weeks. Please can parents support their child by making sure they have somewhere quiet to revise and that they encourage their child to be revising each evening. These exams will form an invaluable part of the support for your child so attendance in school is of the utmost importance each day.

To support students with their preparation for these examinations, teachers will post on ClassCharts topic lists so students know what they should be revising. All topic lists will be on ClassCharts by Friday 13th May. If you child is unsure of what they should be revising please do contact your child's teacher using their <u>initialsurname@courtfields.net.</u>

Revision guides are also available for most subjects and these can be purchased through Scopay and your child will be informed to collect via the school's finance team.
