Work Experience 2022—it is so nice to receive positive feedback from the businesses that hosted our students for work experience.

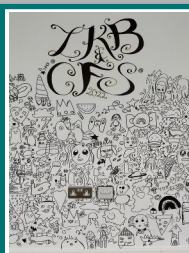
