Congratulations to Asa, Jess, Lily and Andrei on winning the public vote for their informative podcast about Knife Crime!



School Formula 1 Championship Race Report


This week saw the final race in our event filled racing calendar. With a lot of excitement the cars club travelled to Germany to fight out the culmination of a years racing.

Free School Meal Holiday Vouchers

Free school meal vouchers during the holidays have been funded by Somerset County Council and the school are will be sent out this week.

Somerset Household Support Fund

In addition to the vouchers, the council has set up a web portal for families in urgent need (not just those who have free school meals) to get emergency help. Through the web portal **Somerset Household Support** Fund families in need of urgent support can get additional food vouchers. The web portal is commissioned by Somerset County Council and run by Auriga. This portal can also provide fuel vouchers and can help with other urgent essentials such as white goods.
