M Shed Slavery Trip To Bristol

Year 8 students went to Bristol to see local history in action. They partook in an artefact session that outlined the history and culture of Benin, through to the merchant records taken onboard ships and items that were used to punish enslaved people on the plantations. The museum displayed Colston's statue that was removed during the Black Lives Matter protest, as well as outlining the history of the slave trade. Finally, students were taken on a guided tour of various places in Bristol to see the impact that the vast amount of wealth produced during the slave trade had, how Pero is remembered as a slave and whether Bristol represents its history accurately.



Bristol Art Trip

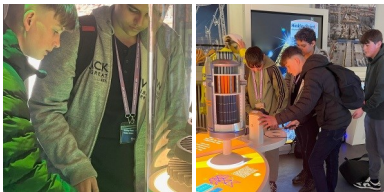

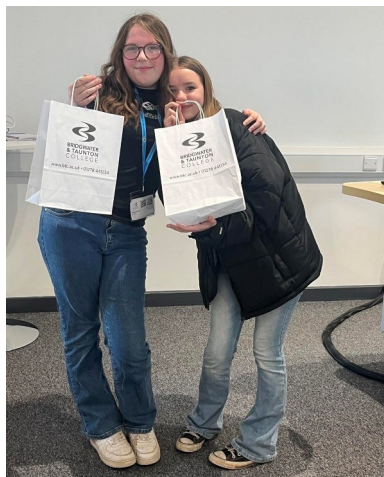
