These appointments are in addition to the existing activities we do in school, and parents or guardians are also welcome to attend if they wish. ### First Aid and Illness

As advised in our Parent Guide, we offer First Aid support at break and lunch, and on an emergency basis. If your child is unwell during the school day they must speak to their teacher, or go to the Hub at break or lunch time. Students are not allowed to contact parents directly to request collection – this is part of our Safeguarding procedures. Once they visit the Hub, they will be triaged by a trained First Aider, and parents contacted as appropriate.



We are also able to offer heat/cold packs and paracetamol to students (as long as you have given consent, and between the hours of 11am and 2pm) to support students to stay in school where possible.
